Millermon presented Clerk of Courts update. Stated COC is short staffed and will be for a while. Stated COC has hired two new clerks.

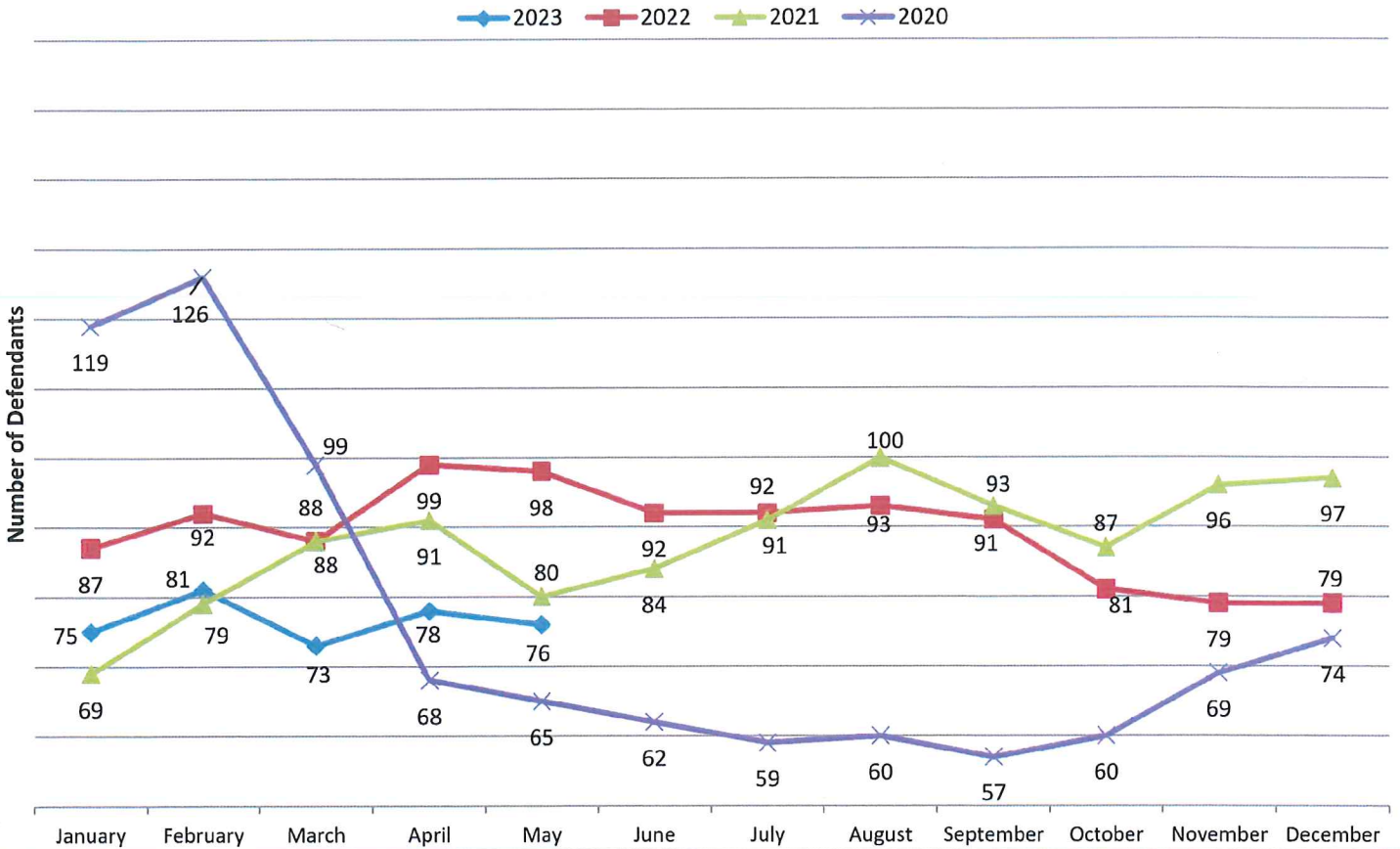

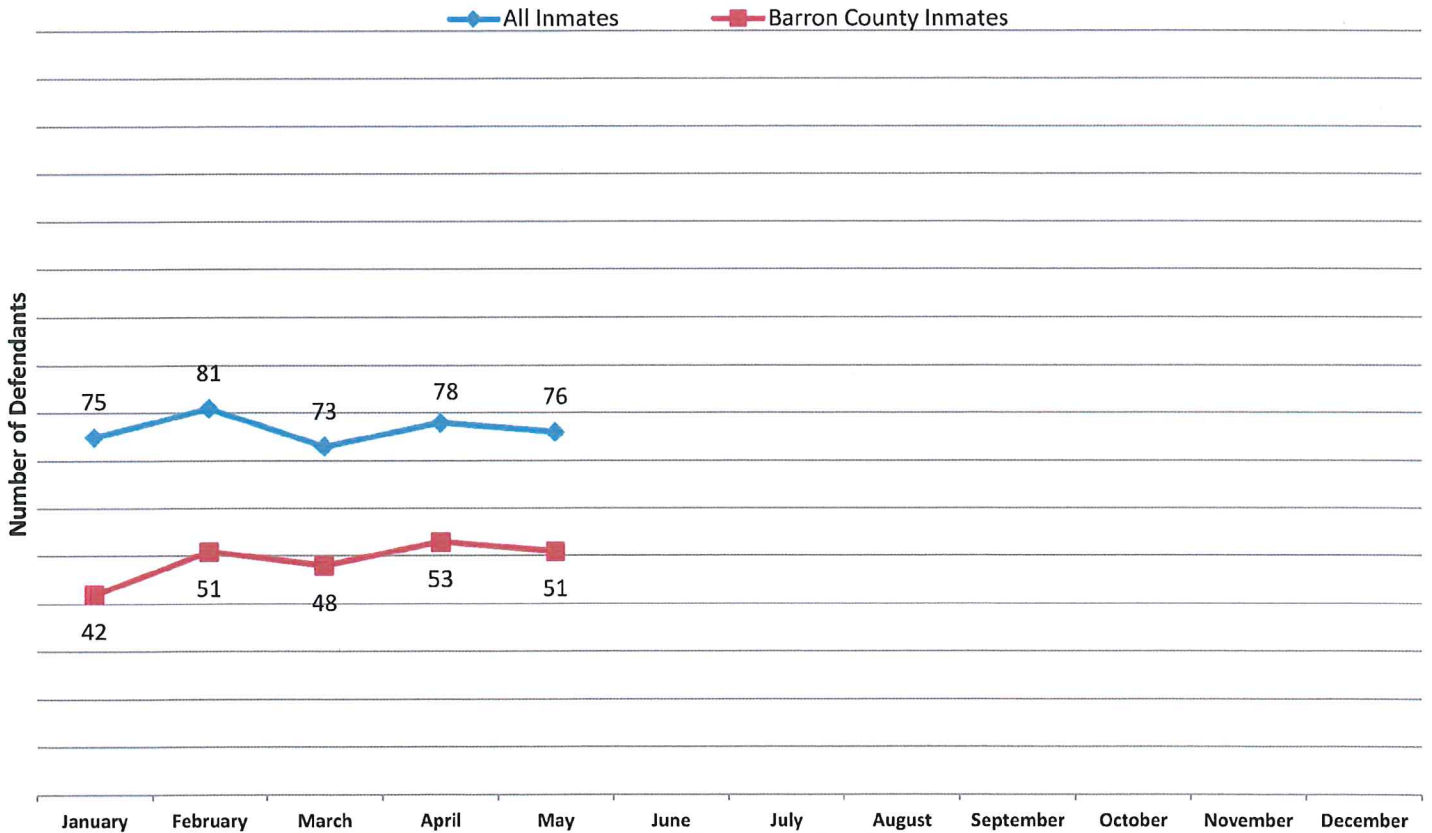

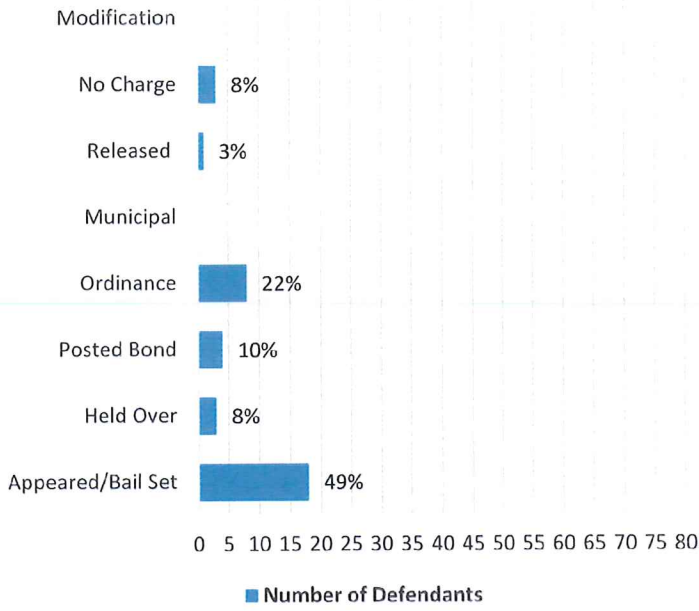
Barron County Average Daily Population Comparison



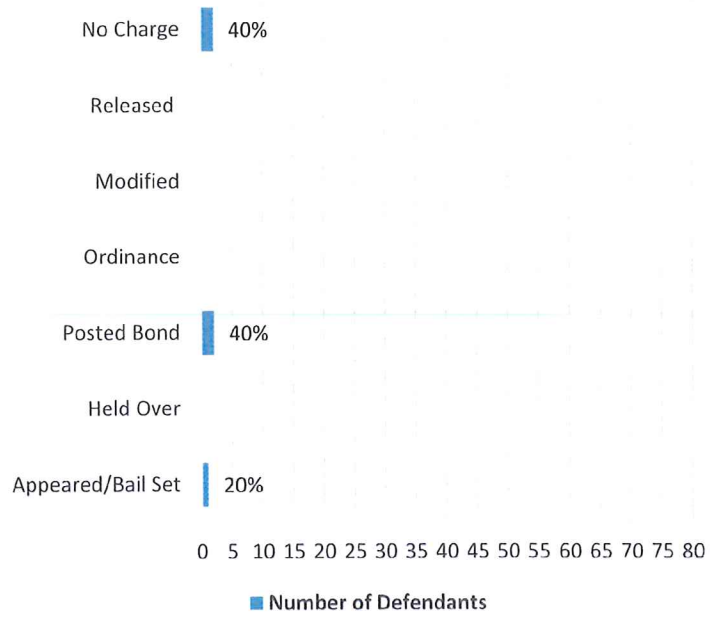
Barron County 2023 Average Daily Population



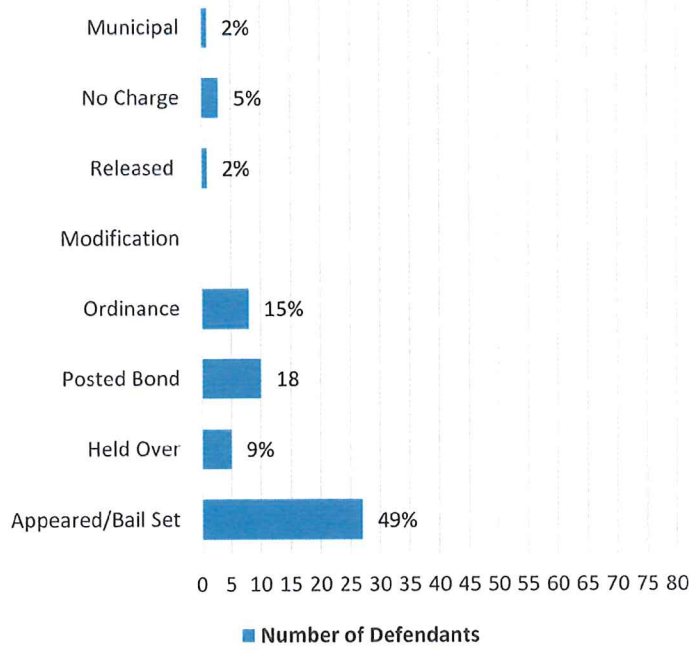
Barron County April 2023 Jail Roster Summary



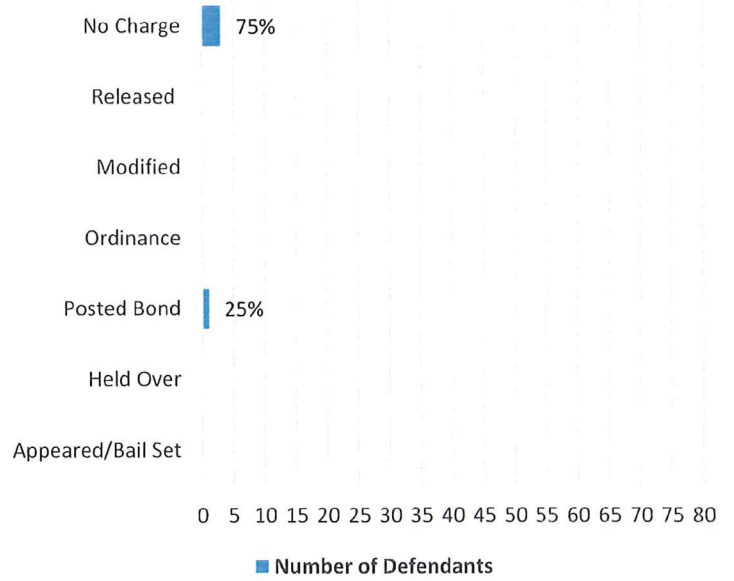
Barron County April 2023 Bail Jumping Charges



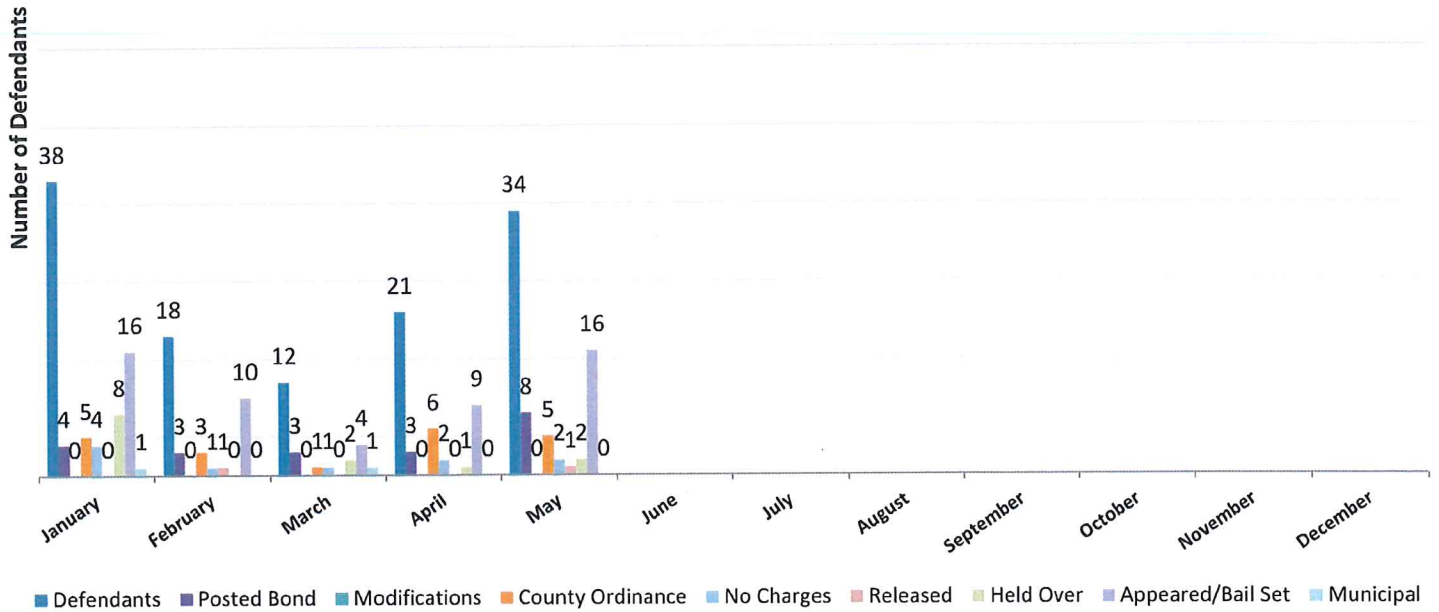

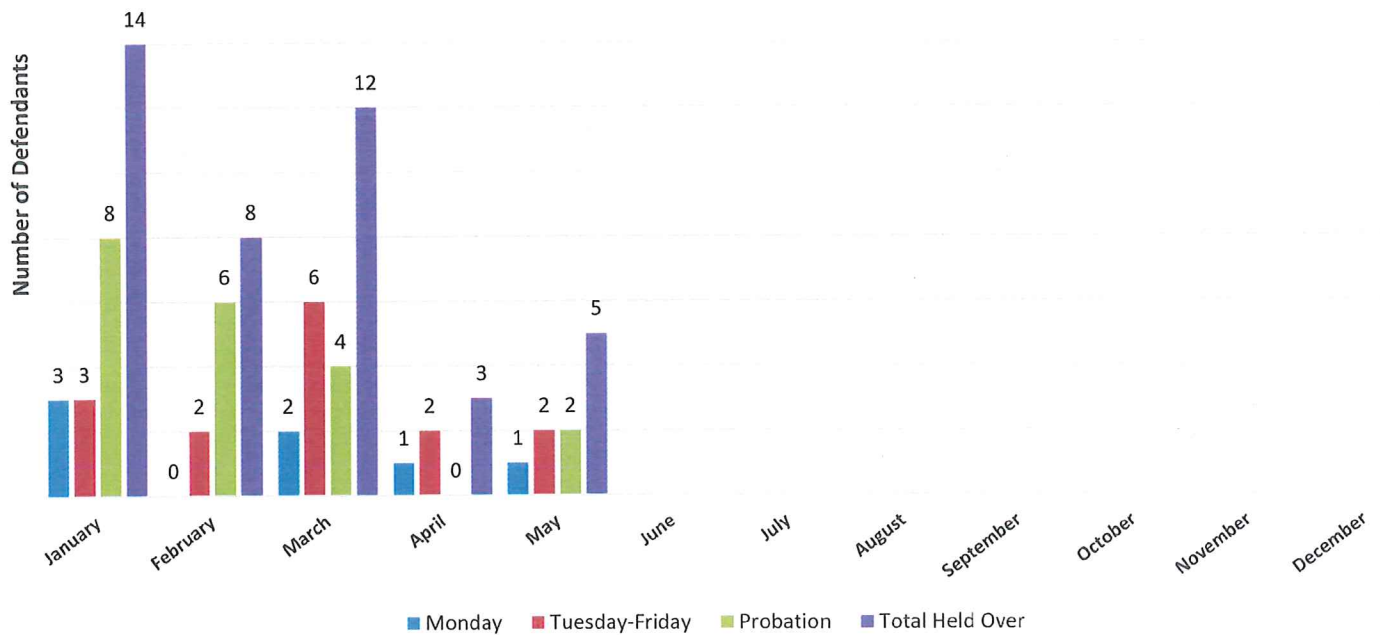
Barron County May 2023 Bail Jumping Charges

Barron County 2023 Hold Over Summary



In April 2023, 75 cases were closed. Of those cases, 21 defendants were sentenced to probation in 28 cases. One separate defendant was sentenced to prison with extended supervision. One defendant is eligible for expungement.

Of the 28 cases:

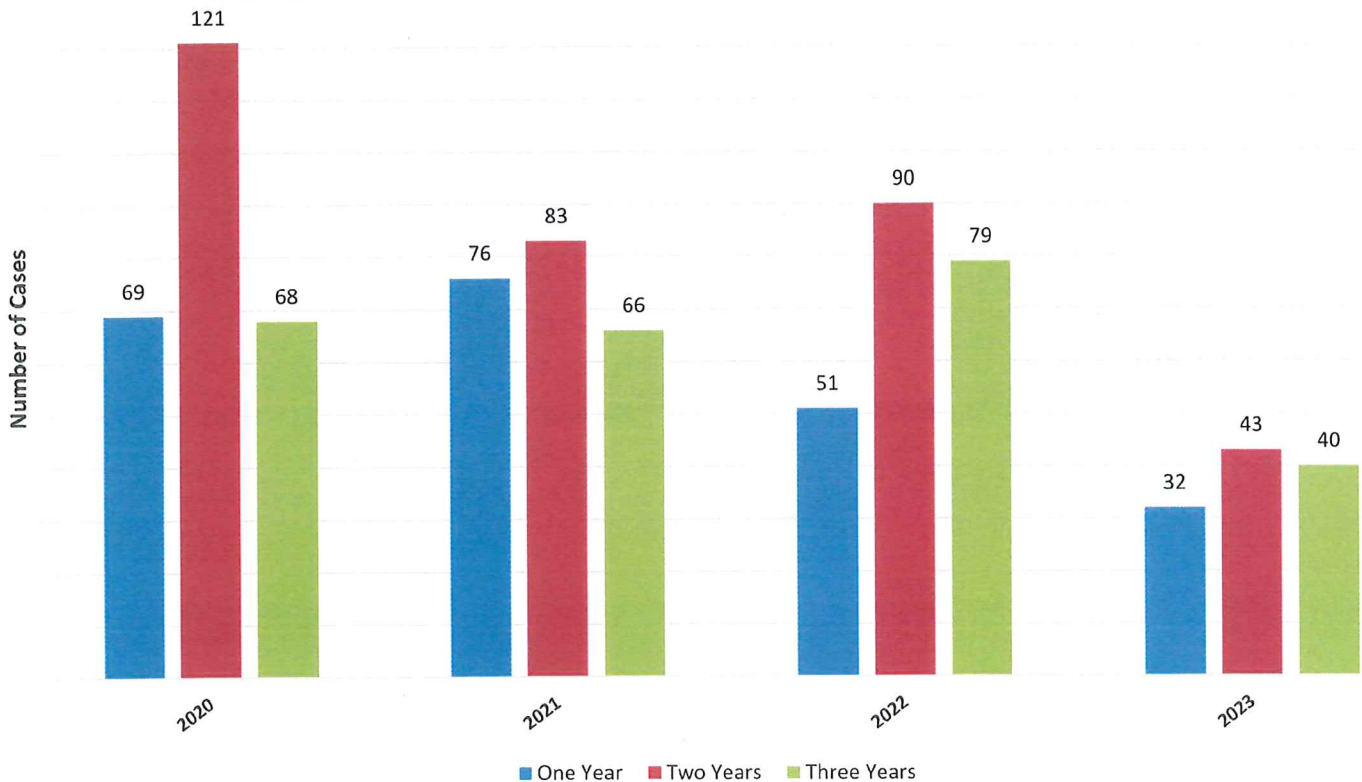
- 6 cases ordered one year of probation
- 12 cases ordered two years of probation
- 10 cases ordered three years of probation

In May 2023, 60 cases were closed. Of those cases, 17 defendants were sentenced to probation in 21 cases. Two separate defendants were sentenced to prison with extended supervision. One defendant is eligible for expungement.

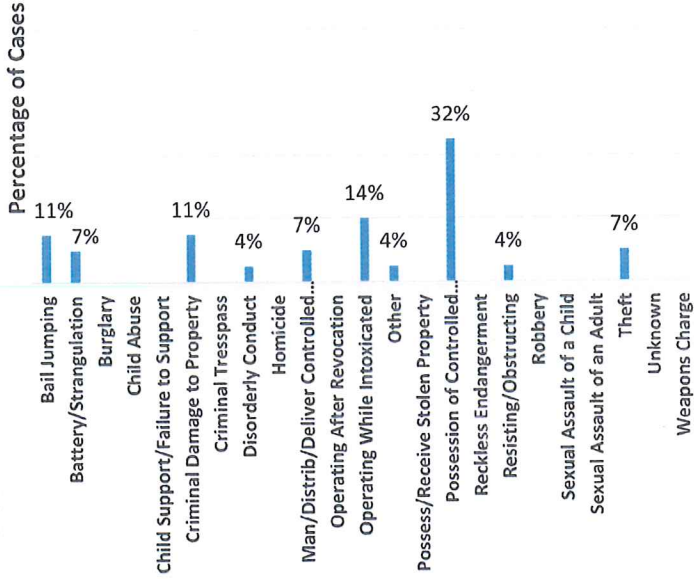
Of the 21 cases:

- 3 cases ordered one year of probation
- 6 cases ordered two years of probation
- 11 cases ordered three years of probation
- 1 case ordered four years of probation

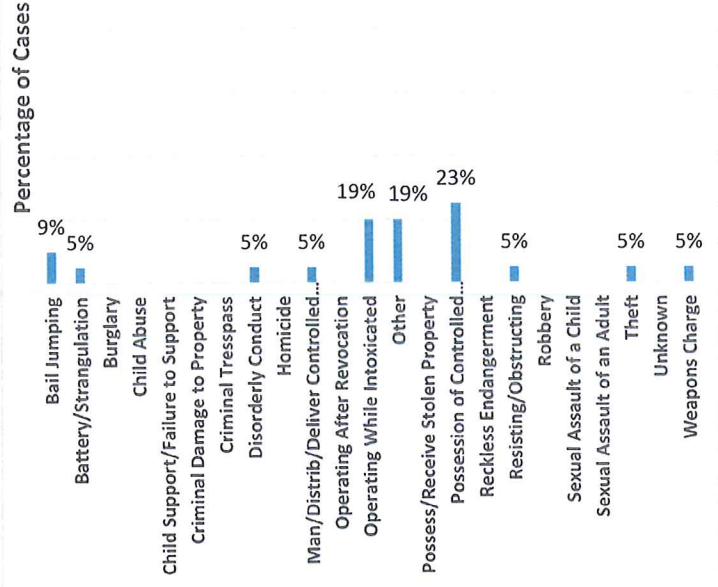
Barron County Probation Term Comparison



Barron County April 2023 Probation Case Summary



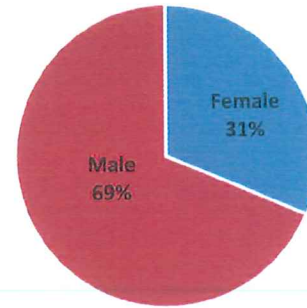

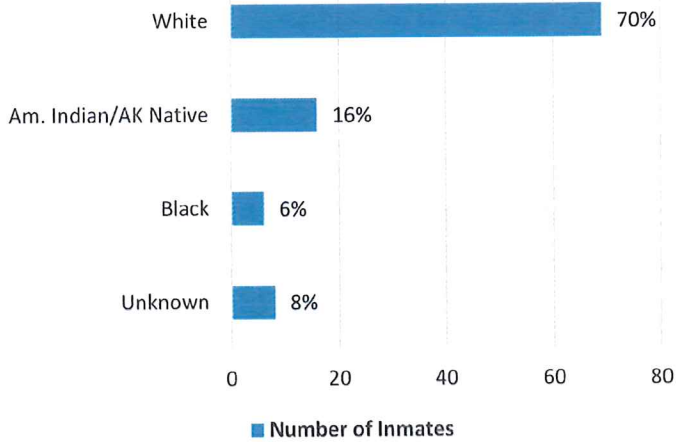

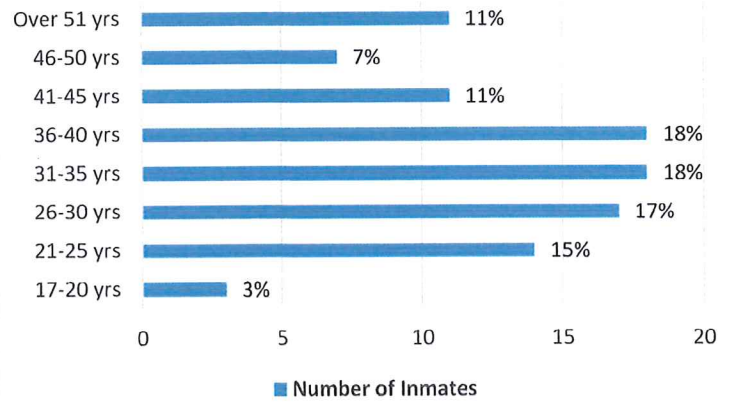

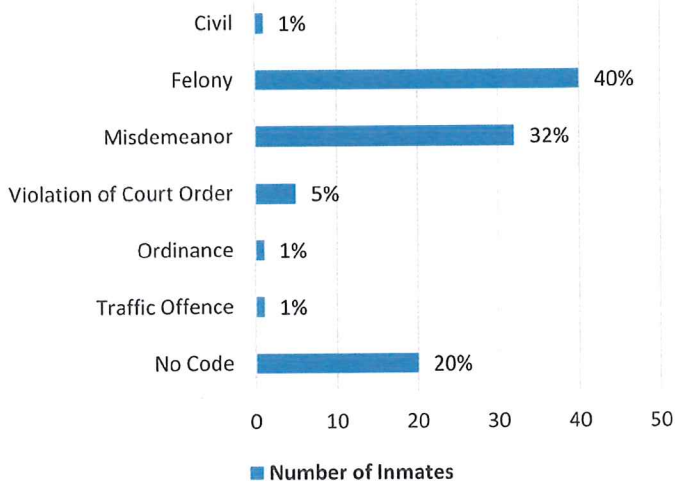

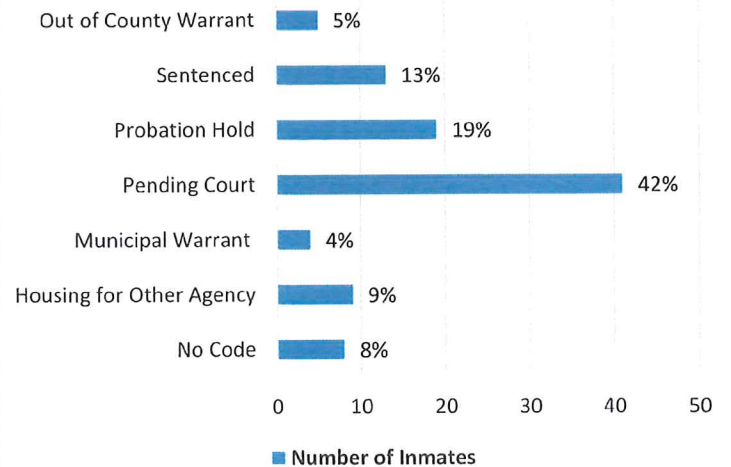

Inmate Crime Classification



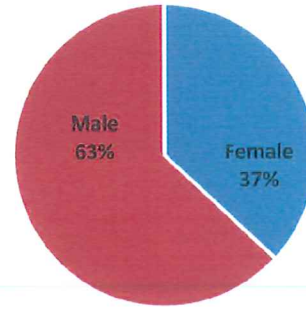
Inmate Judicial Status



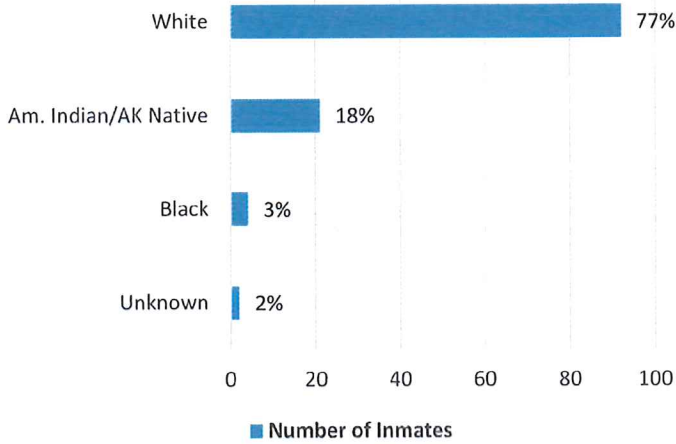

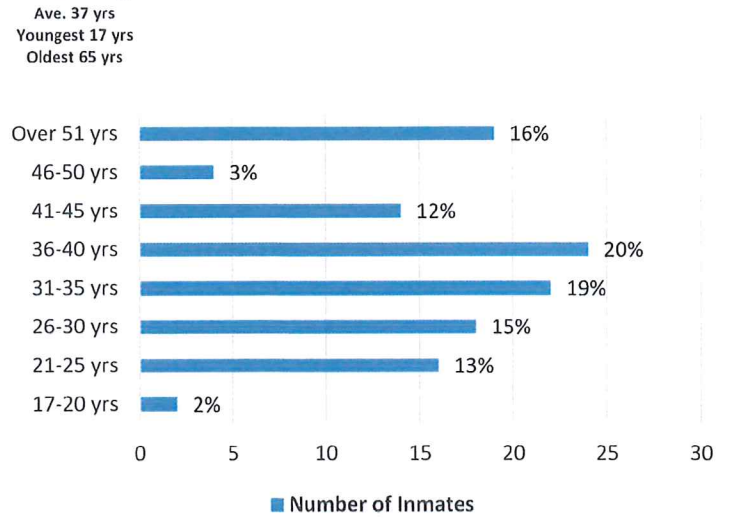

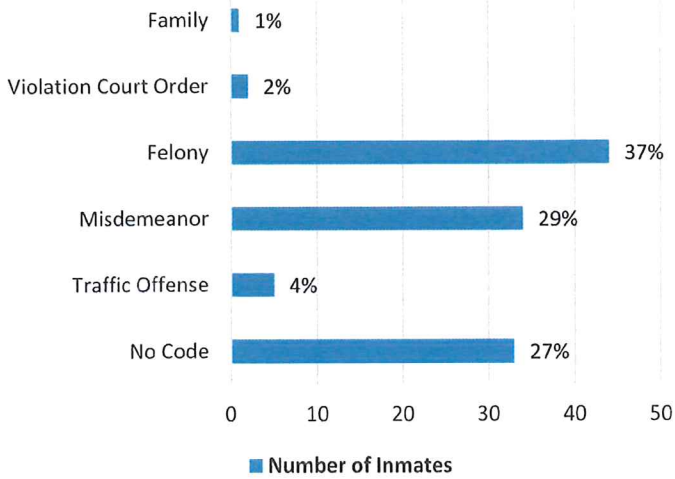
