Meeting called to order by Judge James Babler at 11:55 a.m. Public meeting notification read by Babler. Motion Schmidt/Frolik to approve agenda. Motion carried. Motion Fitzgerald/Schmidt to approve minutes. Motion carried.

Babler presented all data reports. Council discussed. Fitzgerald gave jail operations update. Council discussed.

Vice-Chair election. Babler stated Fitzgerald agrees to serve another term. Motion Frolik/French to elect Fitzgerald as Vice-Chair of Barron County CJCC. Motion carried. Fitzgerald accepts nomination.

Roux presented Chief Justice Summit of Mental Health Summary. Stated Babler, Frolik, and Hay also attended. Stated a need for a regional help center. Hay stated already established workgroup addressing law enforcement and mental health collaboration. Council discussed. Stated Harrington will help workgroup develop a system map.

Harrington provided update on new National Standards for Criminal Justice Coordinating Councils. Stated currently working on updating bylaws. Asked for subcommittee to assist in update. Babler and Fitzgerald will join Harrington in subcommittee. Harrington will present updated bylaws for council's approval at next meeting.

Council discussed methamphetamine updates. Fitzgerald provided law enforcement update. Frolik presented DHHS update.

Future agenda items: Approval of new bylaws. Update from law enforcement and mental health collaboration workgroup.

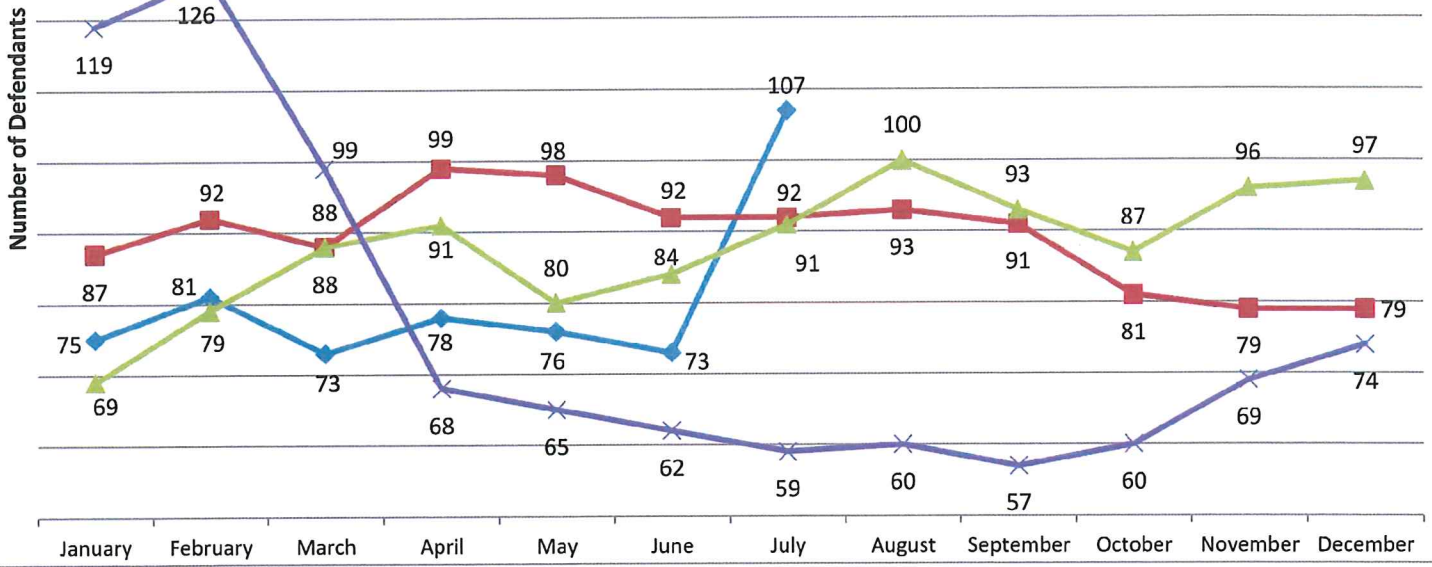
Motion Schmidt/French to adjourn meeting. Meeting adjourned 12:38 p.m.

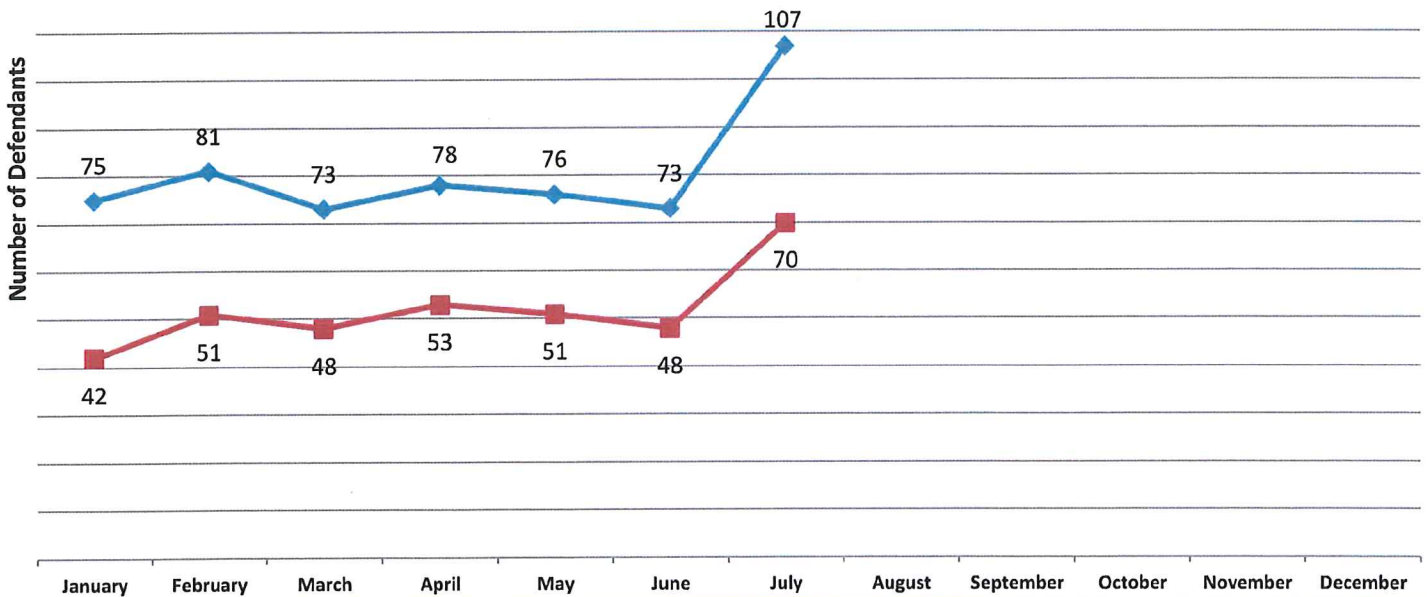
Barron County Average Daily Population Comparison

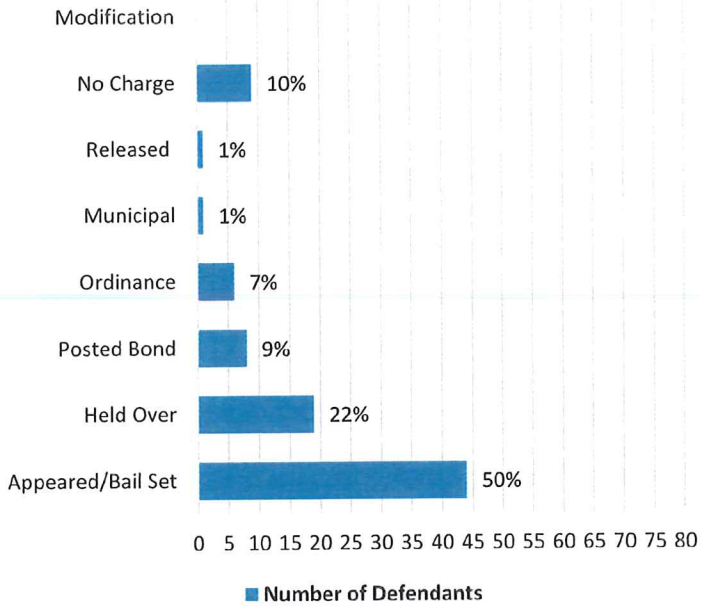


Barron County 2023 Average Daily Population

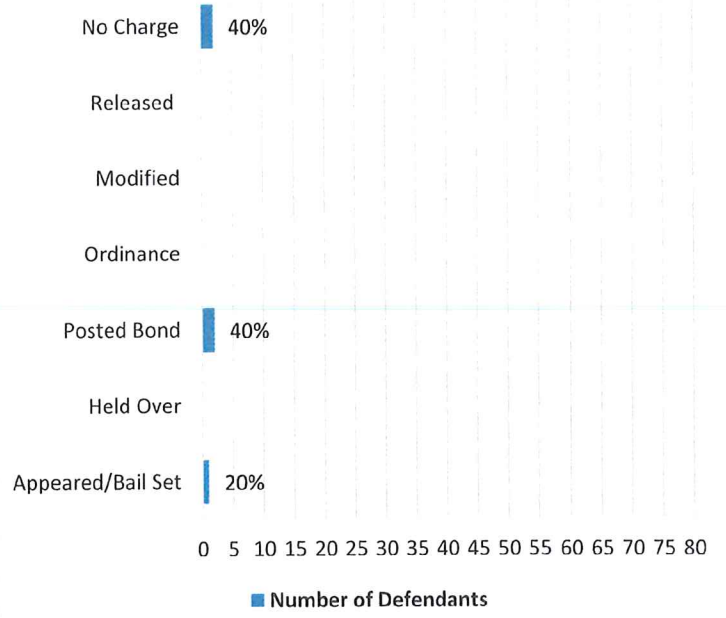

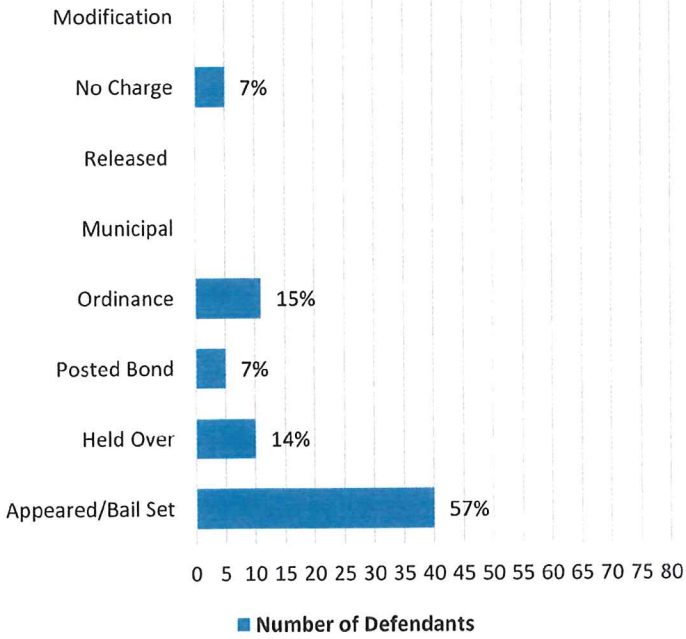
Barron County June 2023 Jail Roster Summary



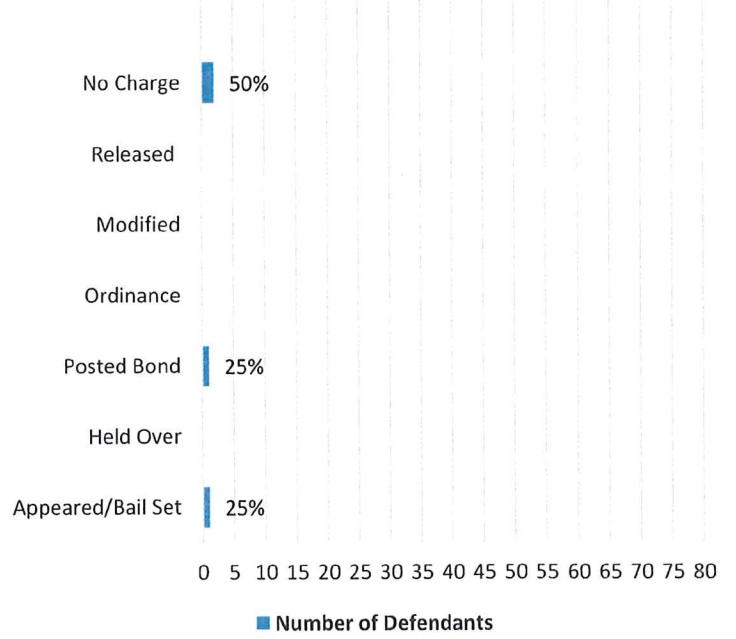
Barron County June 2023 Bail Jumping Charges



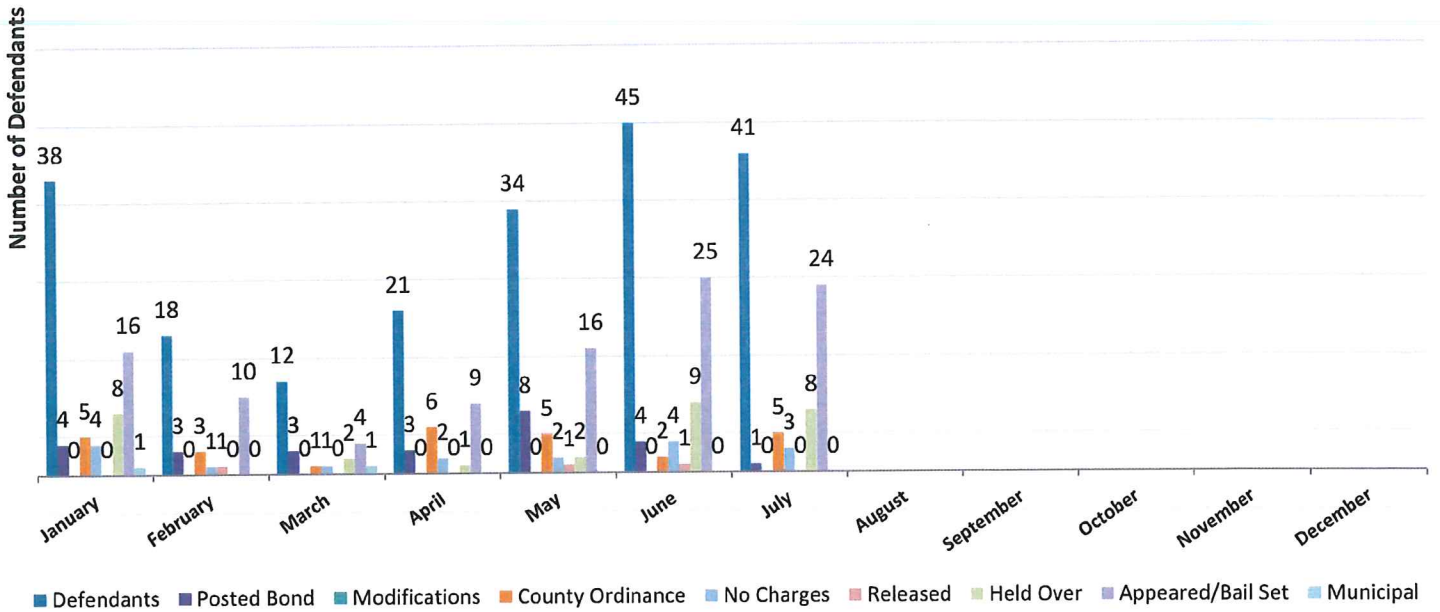

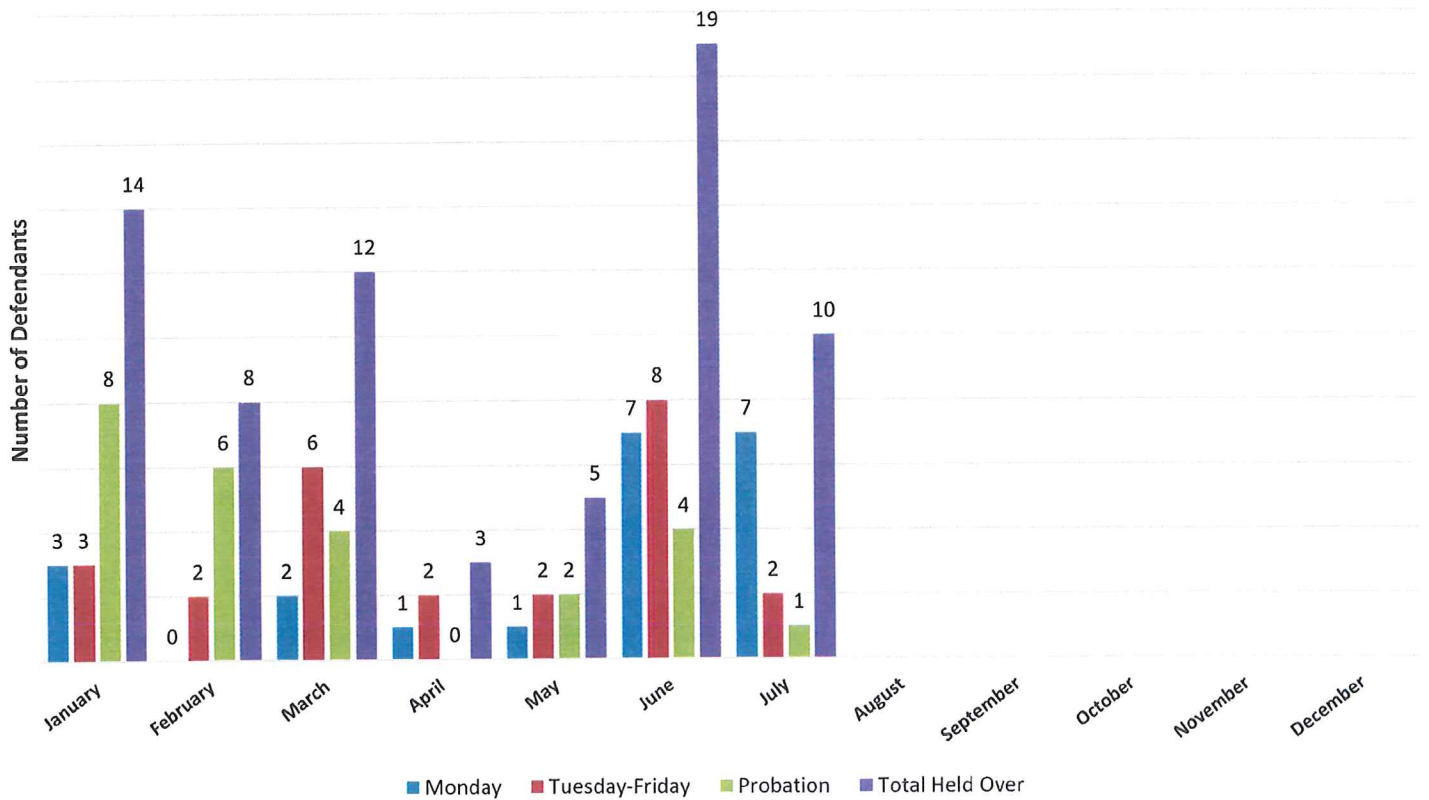
Barron County July 2023 Bail Jumping Charges

Barron County 2023 Hold Over Summary



In June 2023, 67 cases were closed. Of those cases, 16 defendants were sentenced to probation in 18 cases and 4 defendants were sentenced to prison with extended supervision in 7 cases. One defendant is eligible for expungement.

Of the 18 cases:

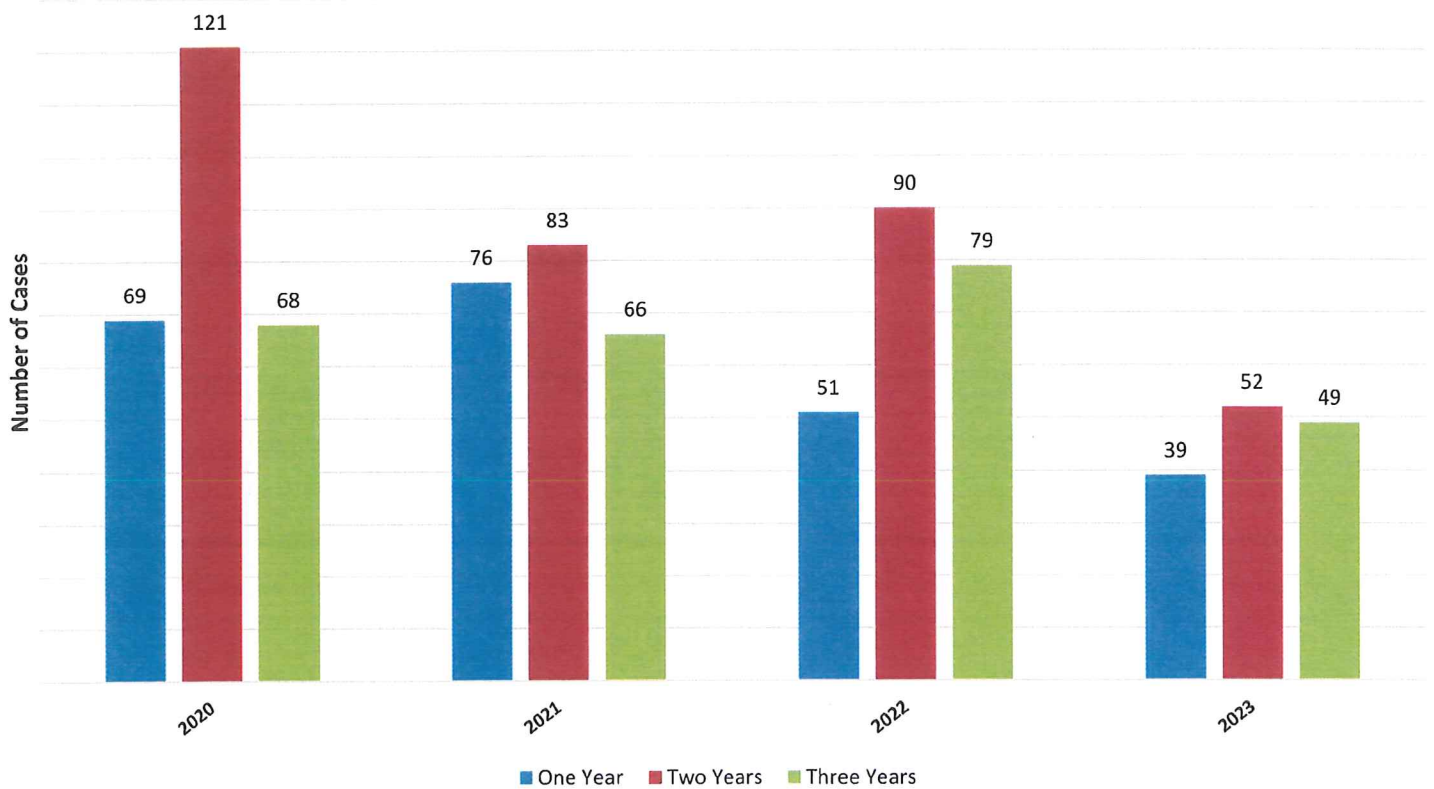
- 6 cases ordered one year of probation
- 6 cases ordered two years of probation
- 5 cases ordered three years of probation
- 1 case ordered ten years of probation

In July 2023, 48 cases were closed. Of those cases, 11 defendants were sentenced to probation in 11 cases and 8 defendants were sentenced to prison with extended supervision in 9 cases.

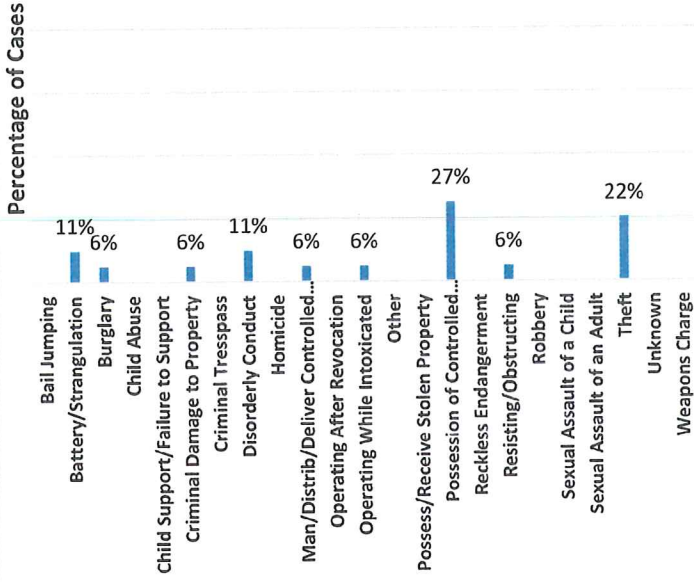
Of the 11 cases:

- 1 case ordered one year of probation
- 5 cases ordered two years of probation
- 4 cases ordered three years of probation
- 1 case ordered six years of probation

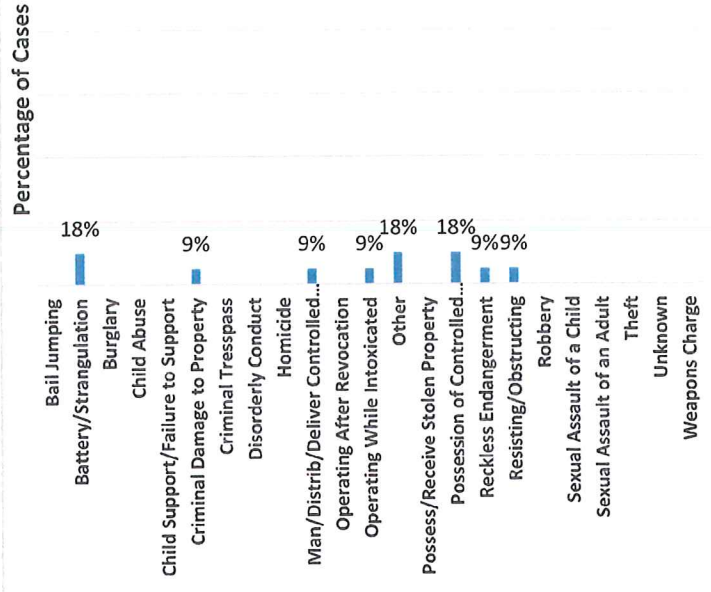
Barron County Probation Term Comparison



Barron County June 2023 Probation Case Summary



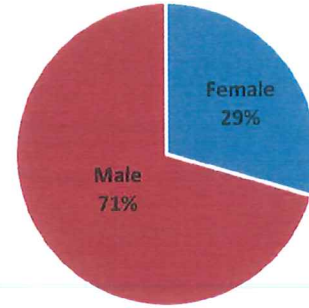
Barron County July 2023 Probation Case Summary



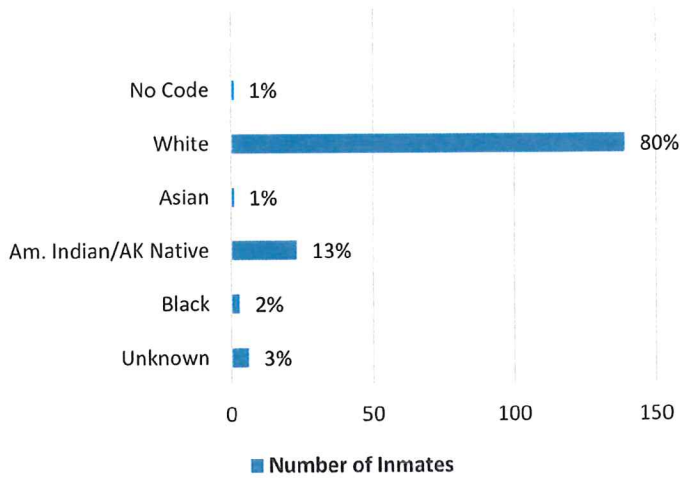

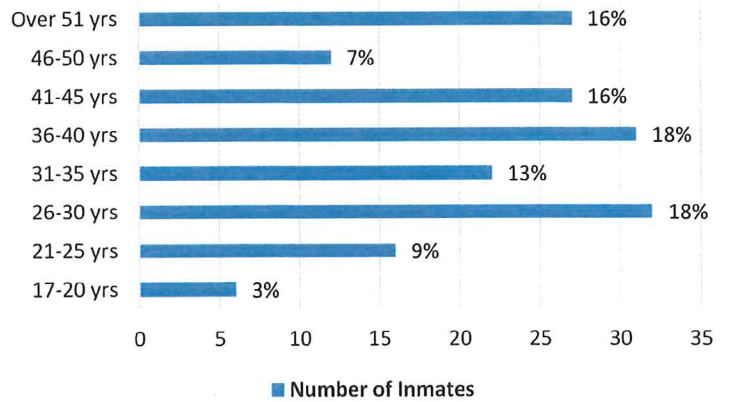


Inmate Race

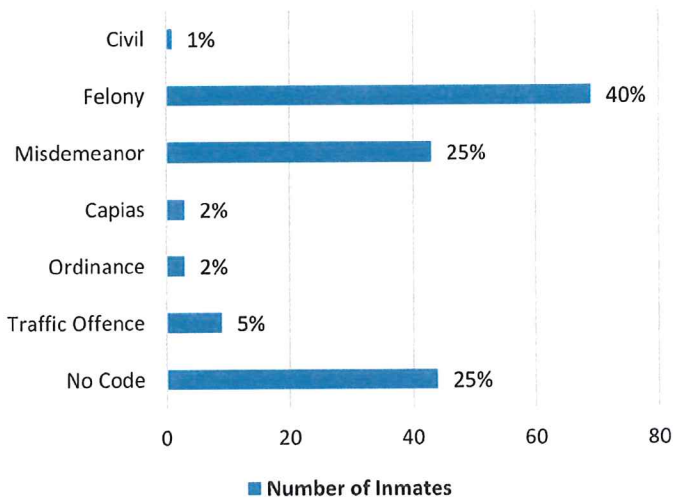


Inmate Age

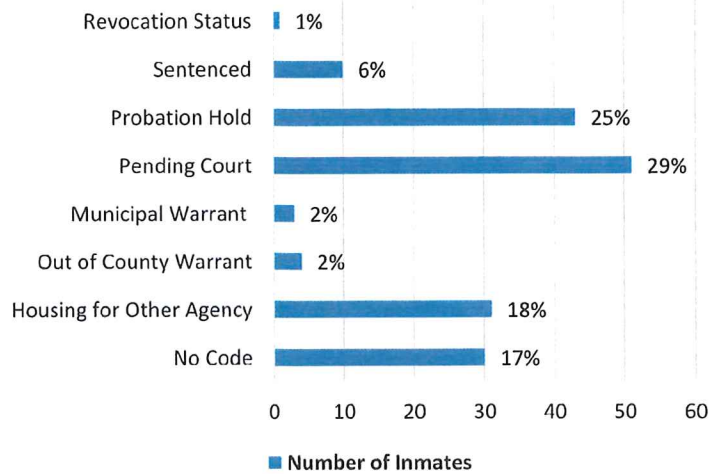

Inmate Crime Classification



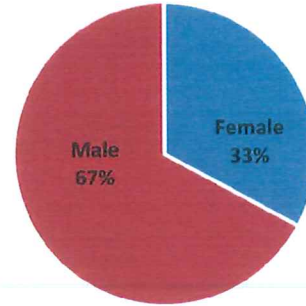
Inmate Judicial Status



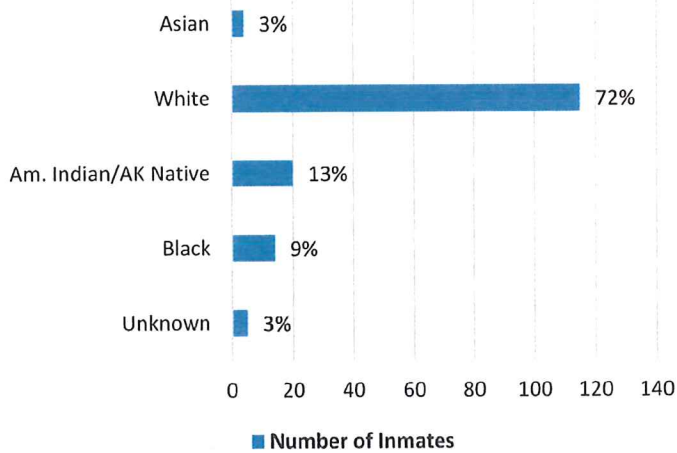

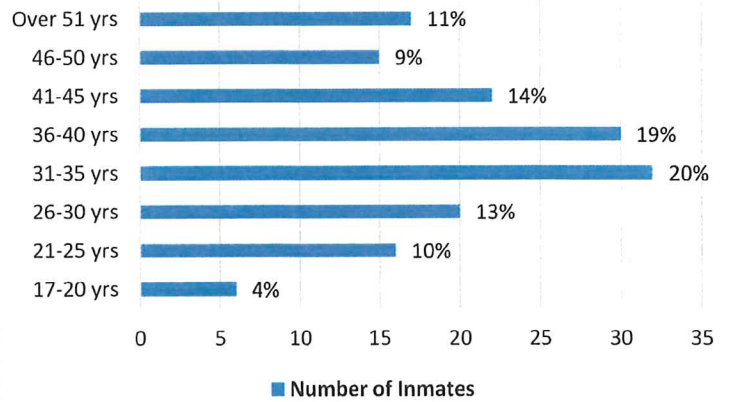

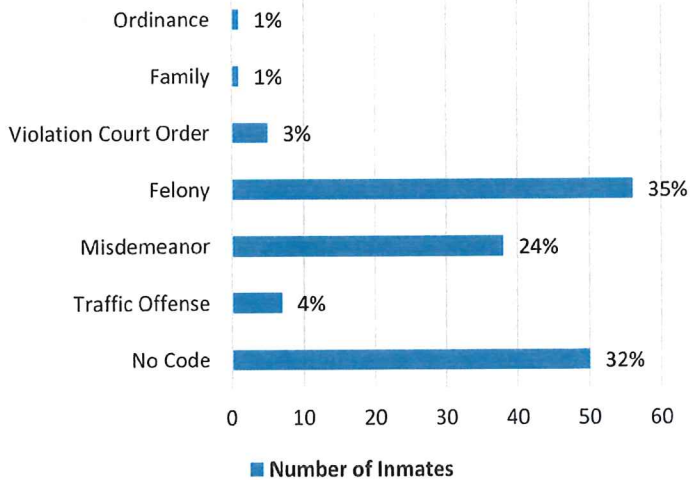
