### July 27th, 2023, Meeting Summary

#### Chair's Comments

Peterson thanked all for their attendance.

### **Financial**

Larson gave a quarterly update on the NoRTAC budget. \$6,694 in budget, as of Oct. 1<sup>st</sup>. Motion to approve financial report by Johnson; seconded by Corbin - Approved

#### ORV Council update (Thole)

The council met in early December with a light agenda. Discussed trail routes, dust control as a maintenance item, and campground funding. Campgrounds to be funded at 50%, as long as they are within close proximity to an existing trail. Mike P. brought up the ide of a letter of support for this decision by the Council. Motion to draft letter by Smedegard; seconded by Mrotek - Approved

# SRC/AWSC update (Smedegard)

SRC met in December topics included bridge and trail ranking tools. Bridges with inspections will rank higher for funding purposes. PE/Contractor documentation will be required for the purpose of a valid inspection. 1 application came back with an increase due to mismeasurement. AWSC - Trego interchange issue was brought up in meeting, by State Senator Quinn. Fix permitted and Engineering underway. Fix will be funded by DOT. A new group formed- Next- Gen Riders (ages 21-35). 2 people running for treasurer. In legislation news supporting: an increase in funding cap, ATV/UTV for emergency use, seasonal roads with no maintenance; not supporting bill for seizing condemned property for rec use. AWSC hosting International Snowmobile Congress, in Green Bay in June.

### Issue Briefs (Peterson)

No new briefs.

### <u>User Survey (Larson)</u>

Some tweaks made to flow and language since the last meeting. ATV Survey has 300+ responses. Snowmobile survey not much due to lack of snow. Heller mentioned the idea of paper survey, in addition to digital.

### SNARS Discussion (Shutt)

Washburn County is having viewing grooming entries from clubs, after they are submitted to state. Meyer said that in Douglas County they use a custom excel spreadsheet.

### Emergency Response Trail Markers Discussion

<u>T</u>ollander: Burnett County uses numbered intersection markers for response routing. Mattson: Bayfield county implementing US National Grid System signage on Hiking Trails, brought an example sign. Wolfe: Barron using Cell phone triangulation. Gullickson: Chippewa County using electronic System. Peterson; Washburn county uses signage corresponding to fire numbers at ½ mile intervals. This topic should be a future agenda item for purposes of possibly moving to a unified system.

County Updates Relating to Trail Development/Maintenance and Other Projects or Points of Interest

Barron (Wolfe) — Quiet with lack of snow. The first half of Cattail rehab is done, will resume in spring. Applying for funding of another ATV park in an unused gravel pit. Heller: Barron County Ride with the Queen event will be taking place at the end of February.

Bayfield (Mattson) – Train trestle crossing closed along Hwy 63. Bridge inspections to begin on an annual cycle. County Alliance discussed the option of brushing using snow maintenance dollars.

Burnett (Tollander) – 2 New bridges installed. The highway department has been doing trail work throughout January. If the weather holds out, they are going to do some more gravelling. All-season trails have been in use.

Chippewa (Krumenauer) – ATV riders want to ride on roads 9nstead of trails. In March County will be voting on opening highways.

Douglas (Meyer)- Not many people on trails, some on RR grades. Still working on bridge project w/ lack of snow. Park and Ride being developed, in Gordon.

Polk (Johnson) – Introduced new County Parks and Trails Supervisor, Tony Nowak. 4<sup>th</sup> week on the job, came over from the Village of Greenville. No Decision on Stower trail in courts as of yet.

Sawyer (LaReau) – Alliance met; trails now partially open. Issues with trail crossing maintenance/permitting. Re-route of Corridor 8 having trouble making headway with USFS due to turnover in offices.

Washburn (Shutt) – Some ATV traffic. Pending rehab projects. One landowner is trying to close trail access. Peterson: WCFA working on Chapter 30 water regs permitting. Umbrella permit that would streamline rec trail permitting significantly.
