1 2 3 4	WHEREAS, Resolution 2022-54 passed on October 17, 2022, authorized \$600,000.00 for "High-Speed Internet Fiber to the Barron County Sheriff's Department Communication Towers"; and
5 6 7 8	WHEREAS, upon final review of these contractual obligations by Mosaic Technologies, they requested the monthly tower fee be increased by \$200 per month; and
9 10 11	WHEREAS, Sheriff Fitzgerald and Administrator French both met with representatives of Mosaic Technologies to address this contractual change and budgetary increase; and
12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, upon further review by Mosaic and the County, a new monthly tower lease rate of \$400.00 per month was agreed upon; and
16 17	WHEREAS , this change results in an additional expenditure of \$72,000.00 in total over the twenty year life of this agreement; and
18 19 20 21	WHEREAS, this resolution was approved by the Executive Committee on January 4, 2023, on a vote of 9 - 0, with Bartlett, Buchanan, Cook, Hanson, Heinecke, Moen, Okey, Rogers and Thompson voting in favor and no members voting against.
22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that with passage of this resolution the Barron County Board of Supervisors does hereby authorize an additional expenditure of \$72,000.00 in connection with Resolution 2022-54 for this project including allowing the County to enter into a twenty (20) year lease with Mosaic Technologies, Cameron, WI for the installation of and use of high-speed fiber to the Communication Towers, tower rental, and other ancillary and necessary expenditures for this purpose; and
