

**BARRON COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2024 - 27**

**Resolution to Set a Fee for  
Escort Assistance  
in the Sheriff's Department**

**TO THE BARRON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

1           **WHEREAS**, there are times it is necessary for the Sheriff's Department to  
2 provide an escort service to individuals moving houses; and

3  
4           **WHEREAS**, there are costs associated with the escort service, including wages  
5 and vehicle maintenance; and

6  
7           **WHEREAS**, it is the recommendation of the Law Enforcement Committee that a  
8 fee of \$150.00 for the initial hour and \$100.00 per hour thereafter be charged to help  
9 offset the wages and vehicle maintenance in providing such a service; and

10  
11           **WHEREAS**, it is the further recommendation that a minimum of five working  
12 days notice be provided to the Sheriff's Department and that the Sheriff's Department  
13 draft a policy outlining the terms and conditions of the escort service.

15           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Barron County Board of  
16 Supervisors does approve that a fee of \$150.00 for the initial hour and \$100.00 per hour  
17 thereafter be charged to individuals requesting the escort services of the Barron County  
18 Sheriff's Department in moving houses.

20           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that five working days notice shall be provided  
21 to the Sheriff's Department when requesting this service, and that the Sheriff's  
22 Department shall draft a policy outlining the terms and conditions of the service.

24           **WHEREAS**, this resolution was approved by the Law Enforcement/Emergency  
25 Management Committee on May 24, 2024, on a vote of 7-0, with Olson, Okey,  
26 Mosentine, Turcott, Anderson, Schneider and Wenzel voting in favor and no members  
27 voting against. Bergeson was absent; and

29           **WHEREAS**, this resolution was approved by the Executive Committee on June  
30 5, 2024, on a vote of 9 - 0, with B. Anderson, Bartlett, Cook, Hanson, Heller (alternate),  
31 Kusilek, Okey, Nelson (alternate) and Wenzel voting in favor and no members voting  
32 against. Rogers and Thompson were absent.

34           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that publication of this resolution may occur  
35 through posting in accordance with Section 985.02 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
