e. Operators must follow all state and local laws pertaining to ATV/UTV			
operation.			
f. ATV/UTV must be registered by the State of Wisconsin.			
g. Operation of all other motor vehicles and other power driven vehicle			
that cannot be officially licensed or registered by the State of Wisconsi			
as a legal highway or recreational vehicle is prohibited.
