

**BARRON COUNTY RESOLUTION NO. 2026 - 4**

**Resolution to Support Wisconsin Establishing a Membership With the Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center (MS-ISAC) to Cover the Cost of Membership for all State, Local, Tribal and Territorial (SLTT) Organizations**

**TO THE BARRON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

1           **WHEREAS**, the Multi-State Information Sharing and Analysis Center (MS-ISAC)  
2 provides vital cybersecurity services, including 24/7 threat monitoring and incident  
3 response, to more than 18,000 state, local, tribal, and territorial (SLTT) government  
4 organizations supporting our nation’s critical infrastructure including public hospitals,  
5 public utilities, K-12 schools and law enforcement; and

7           **WHEREAS**, local governments, especially in rural and under-resourced areas,  
8 have relied heavily on MS-ISAC’s services; and  
9

10           **WHEREAS**, without MS-ISAC services, government organizations are  
11 increasingly vulnerable to cyber-attacks by foreign adversaries; and

13           **WHEREAS**, recent federal funding cuts to MS-ISAC have significantly weakened  
14 the nation’s defense against cyber threats; and

16           **WHEREAS**, this resolutions was recommended for approval by the Executive  
17 Committee at the January 7, 2026 meeting on a vote of 9 - 0 with Cook, Okey, Bartlett,  
18 Kusilek, Olson, Thmpson, Rogers, Wenzel and P. Anderson voting in favor and no  
19 members voting in opposition.

21           **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Barron County Board of  
22 Supervisors that it supports Wisconsin establishing a membership with the Multi-State  
23 Informatin Sharing and Analysis Center (MS-ISAC) to cover the cost of membership for  
24 all state, local, tribal and territorial (SLTT) organizations; and

26           **BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED** that the Barron County Clerk is hereby authorized  
27 to send a copy of this Resolution to the Governor of the State of Wisconsin, all Wisconsin  
28 Counties and the Wisconsin Counties Association for consideration; and

30           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that publication of this resolution may occur  
31 through posting in accordance with Section 985.02 of the Wisconsin Statutes.
