**Gathering Recommendations**

These numbers are recommended **SO LONG AS**

- ✓ 6 feet between households is maintained
- ✓ Increased access to hand washing and/or sanitation is available
- ✓ Masks are required
- ✓ There is control of situations that bring people into close contact (entrance/exit, concessions etc)

✗ Those with increased risk of serious illness should consider limiting attendance at all gatherings.

People are able to spread COVID-19 up to 48 hrs/2 days before they start to feel sick. This means, people will not know that they are sick and able to spread COVID-19. Wearing a mask, social distancing, and limiting gathering sizes are all ways we can help slow the spread of COVID-19 but are not perfect.
