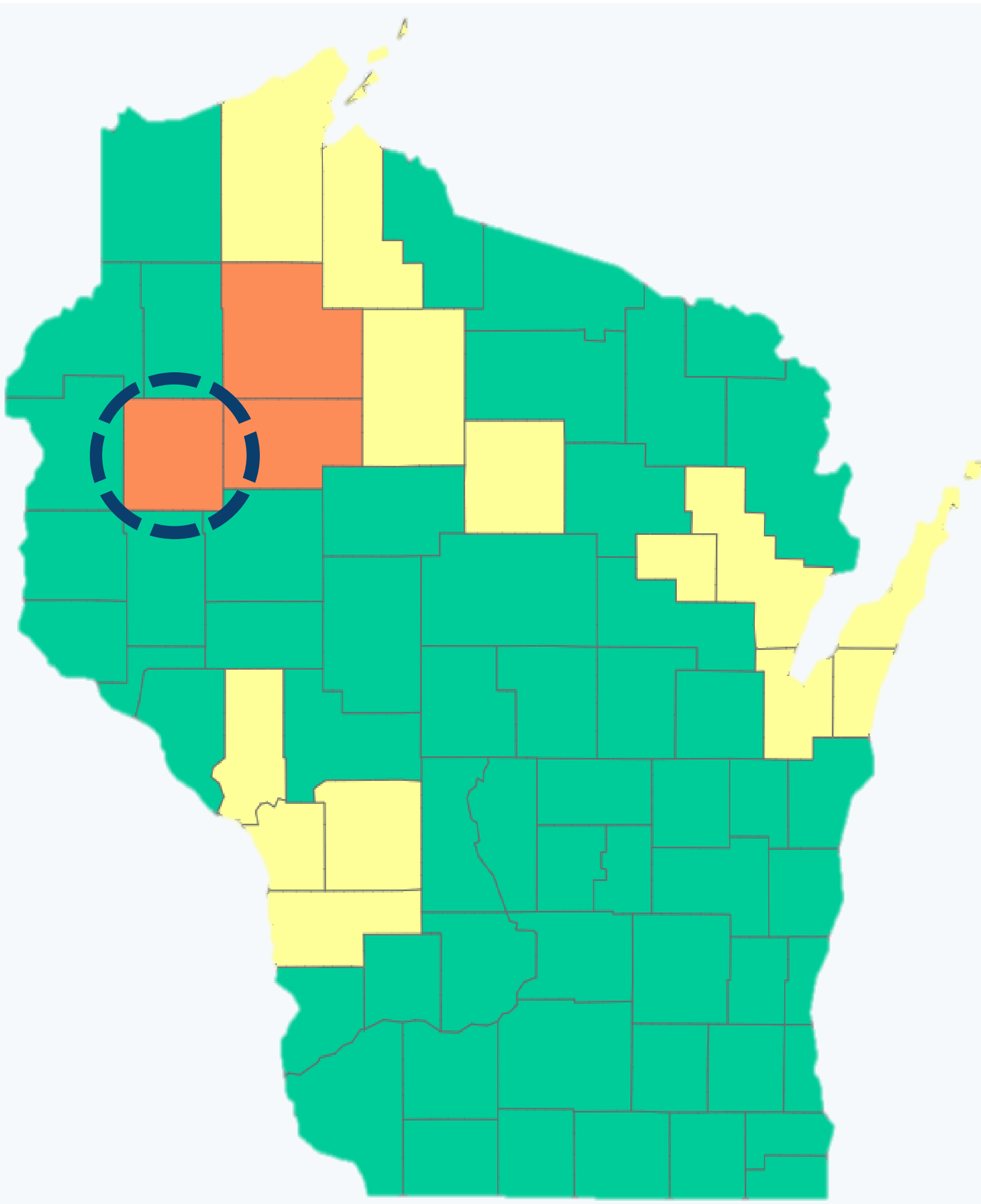


# COVID-19 WEEKLY REPORT

## COVID-19 Community Level

COVID-19 Community Levels are a new tool to help communities decide what prevention steps to take based on the latest data. Levels can be low, medium, or high and are determined by looking at **hospital beds being used, hospital admissions, and the total number of new COVID-19 cases** in an area. Take precautions to protect yourself and others from COVID-19 based on the COVID-19 Community Level in your area.

*\*These recommendations DO NOT APPLY IN HEALTHCARE SETTINGS such as hospitals and nursing homes.*



COVID-19 Community Level	You Should
<b>LOW</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines</li> <li>Get tested if you have symptoms</li> </ul>
<b>MEDIUM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Talk to your doctor about whether or not you need to wear a mask and take other precautions if you are at high risk for severe illness.</li> <li>Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines</li> <li>Get tested if you have symptoms</li> </ul>
<b>HIGH</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear a mask indoors in public</li> <li>Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines</li> <li>Get tested if you have symptoms</li> <li>Take additional precautions as needed if you are at high risk for severe illness.</li> </ul>

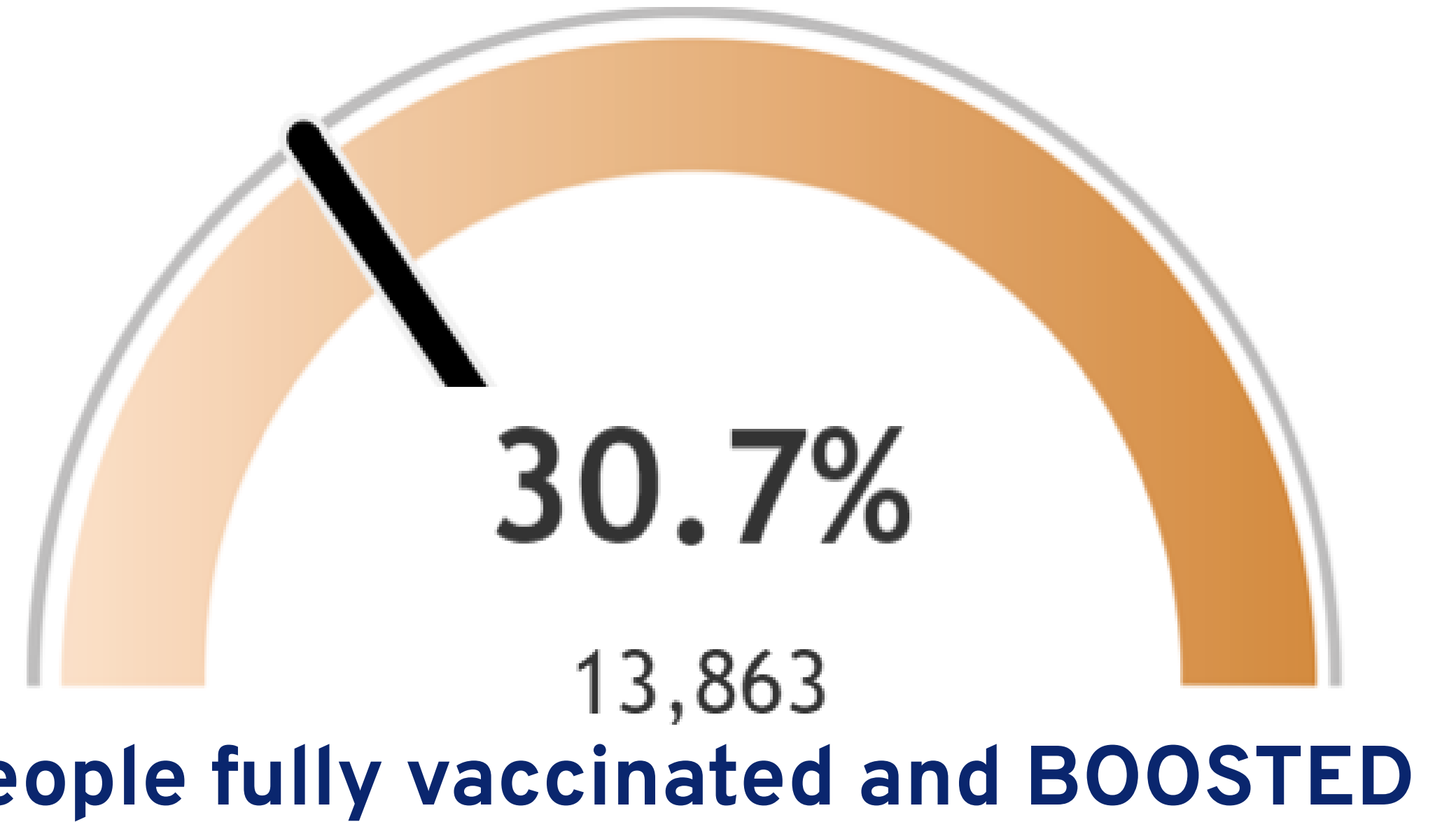
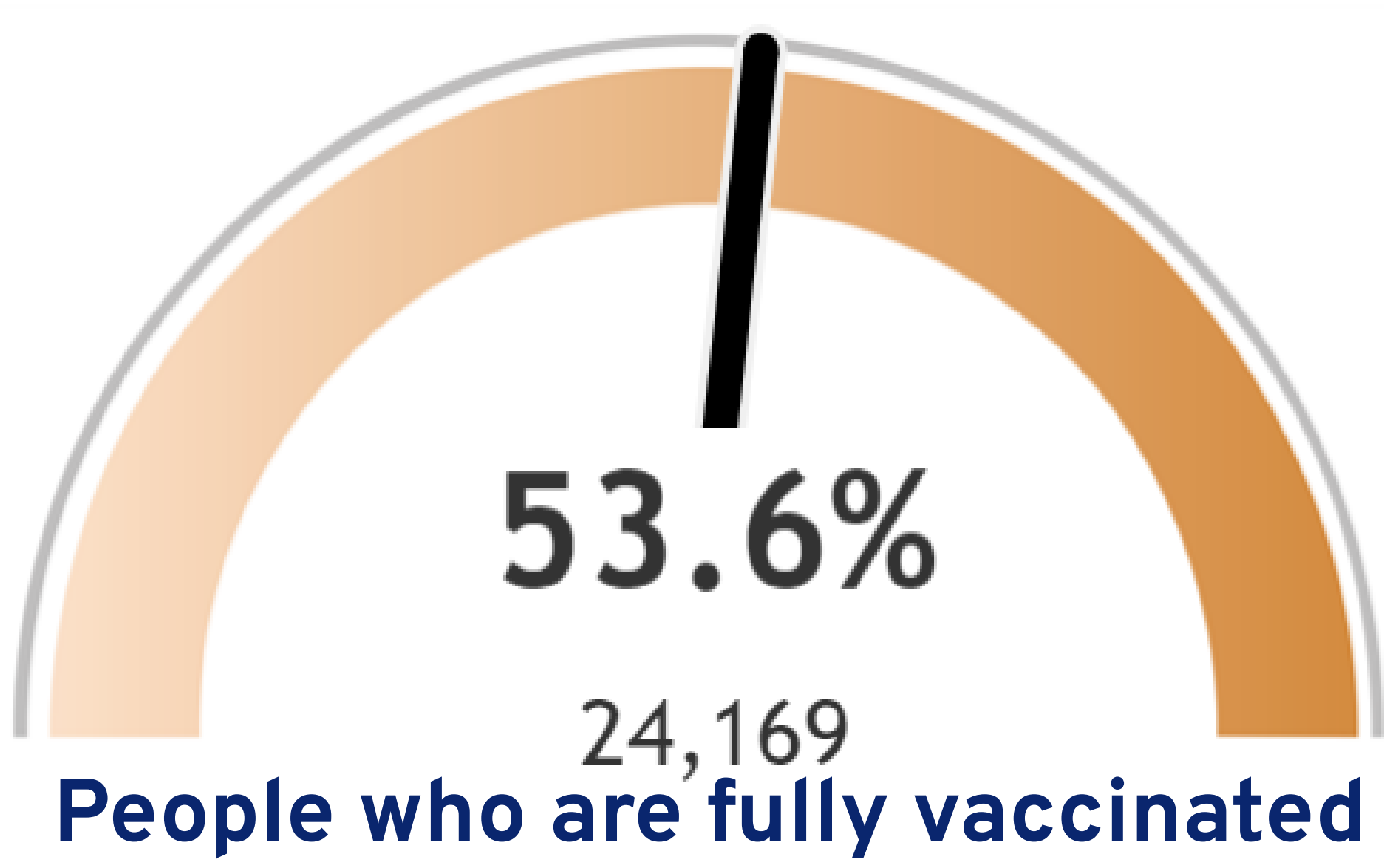

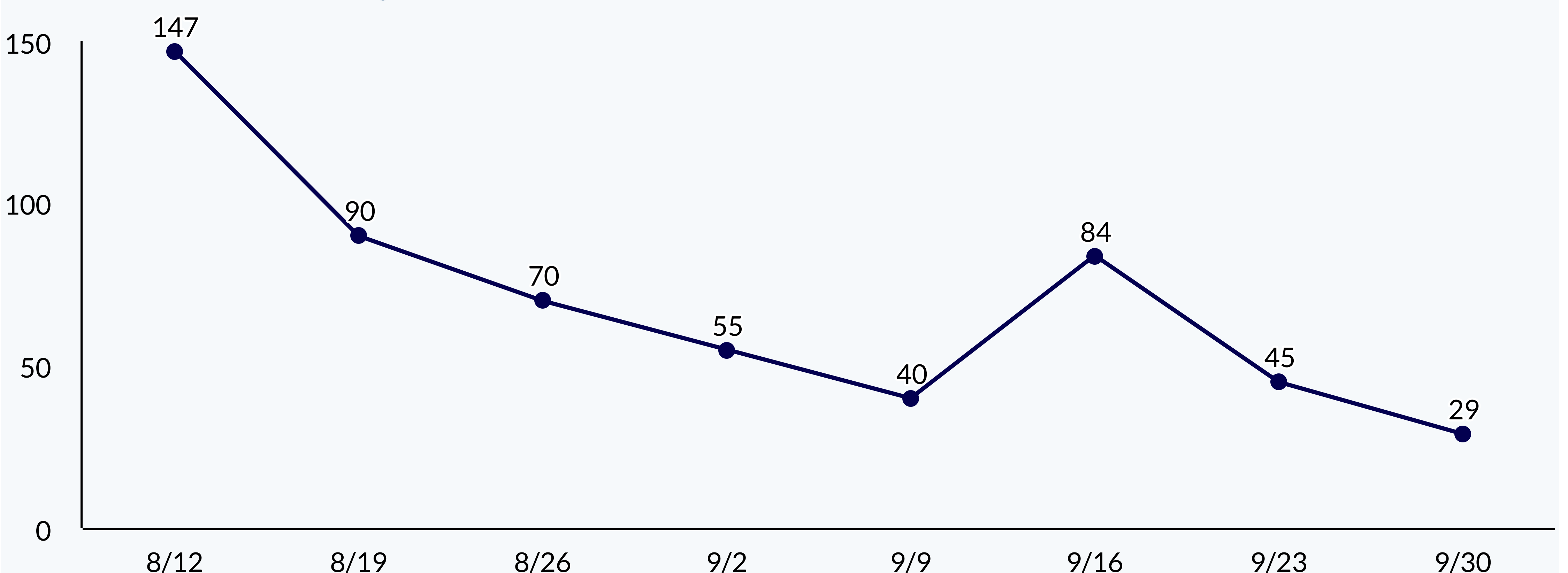
